

## **Importation of Products with MINOR Dairy Components into Jamaica**

Products containing only small quantities of milk (e.g., chocolate) do NOT require veterinary certification by APHIS VS. These products should be allowed entry with a “Certificate of Free Sale” from a competent health authority (Federal, State or local). Exporters may contact the FDA to obtain this type of documentation. Some State Departments of Agriculture or Public Health or local agencies may also issue certificates of free sale.

If such products, accompanied by an appropriate “Certificate of Free Sale”, are refused entry into Jamaica, exporters are advised to contact the Foreign Agriculture Service (FAS) in Jamaica for assistance.
